Sub: Proposal to engage Centre for Study of Science, Technology and Policy (CSTEP) as a Technical Resource Institution.

Preamble:

The Government has engaged the Centre for Study of Science, Technology and Policy (CSTEP), No.18, Mayura street, 10th Cross, Papanna Layout, Nagashettyhalli, RMV 2nd Stage, Bangalore-560 094, as technical resource institution and agreed to utilise the expertise available in CSTEP for a period of two years subject to the condition that their performance is evaluated every year with respect to outcomes and savings accrued in different sectors/departments from the performance projections and appraisal etc. done by CSTEP and is found to be satisfactory.

As per the Cabinet Approval, Project Approval Committee chaired by the Chief Secretary was constituted for entrustment of Studies/Appraisals to CSTEP to engage them as Technical Resource Institution. The Project Approval Committee under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary in its meeting held on 30th July 2016 approved the following six Studies / Appraisals of Government of Karnataka to be taken-up by CSTEP as a Technical Resource Institution.

1. Karnataka's energy mix - Computational Model for Energy Planning
2. Efficient Irrigation Pumps (IPs)
3. Dedicated feeders for IPs using solar based generation
4. Evaluation of BMTC Initiatives on Modal Share
5. Sustainable Urban Planning Strategies for Cities in Karnataka.
6. Integration of BMRCL and BMTC

The first three studies pertain to the Energy Department, study listed at 4 pertains to the Transport Department (BMTC) and study 5 pertains to Urban Development Department & study 6 pertains to Transport Department(BMTC) and Urban Development Department (BMRCL).

In respect of the six studies / appraisals mentioned above; the concerned departments were requested to finalize the costing, Terms of Reference(TOR)s in consultation with CSTEP & provide justification for exemption under Section 4(g) of the KTPP Act, 1999 and send the details to the Planning Department. The concerned departments, namely, Energy, Urban Development and BMTC finalized the costings, TORs and provided justification for exemption under Section 4(g) of KTPP ACT, 1999 for entrusting the studies to CSTEP.

The studies proposed to be undertaken are of significant value to the Government of Karnataka, are complex and require exceptional expertise. As such the exemption under Section 4(g) of the KTPP Act, 1999 was sought for the proposed engagement of CSTEP and the matter was referred to Finance Department, which has given its approval.
